# 7<sup>th</sup> International Young Geotechnical Engineers Conference (7iYGEC) Sydney 2021

Dear YMPG Member,

Planning for the 7<sup>th</sup> International Young Geotechnical Engineers Conference (7iYGEC), in Sydney in 2021, is well advanced and the call for abstracts is now open.

The conference website is live and may be accessed <a href="http://icsmge2021.org/7iygec">here (http://icsmge2021.org/7iygec)</a>.

Each member society is invited to submit up to 4 abstracts, with a minimum of two abstracts to be selected from each member society. The maximum number of delegates is expected to be 100.

As with the ICSMGE, abstract and paper submissions are coordinated, reviewed and submitted to the conference by ISSMGE member societies. Papers may be between 4 and 6 pages in length.

If you are interested in attending, please contact your local ISSMGE member society to inquire about your local selection process.

All abstracts will need to be uploaded to the Conference abstract submission portal by your member society **no later than 31 October 2020**. ### **Submission Guidelines**

- Abstracts must be written in English or in French.
- Abstract submissions must include abstract title, author(s)' name(s), affiliations, theme, up to five keywords, and a presenting author biography (up to 100 words).
- In order to qualify for attendance at the 7iYGEC, registrants must be aged 35 or less as at 31 December 2021 and must be the primary author of the paper.
- Abstract body including references should be in text only and should not exceed 250 words.
- All abstracts should clearly state: Objectives, Methods and Conclusions.
- Abstracts must be submitted by the member society, not by individuals.
- Abstracts must be received by 31 October 2020. Abstracts received after the deadline may not be considered.







### **Abstract Selection**

- The maximum number of abstracts accepted will be 100 and all delegates are expected to present at the conference. Registration is not available to delegates who have not had a paper accepted to the conference.
- Each member society may submit up to 4 abstracts.
- No more than 1 abstract per author.
- Following review, the best 2 abstracts from each member society will be selected for presentation at
  the conference. Member societies are encouraged to rate the abstracts submitted and inform the
  selection committee of their preferred attendees. These views will be considered by the selection
  committee. If, following the first round of selection, the conference quota of 100 is not filled, the
  third best abstracts from each member society will be selected, then fourth best until the conference
  quota is filled.
